

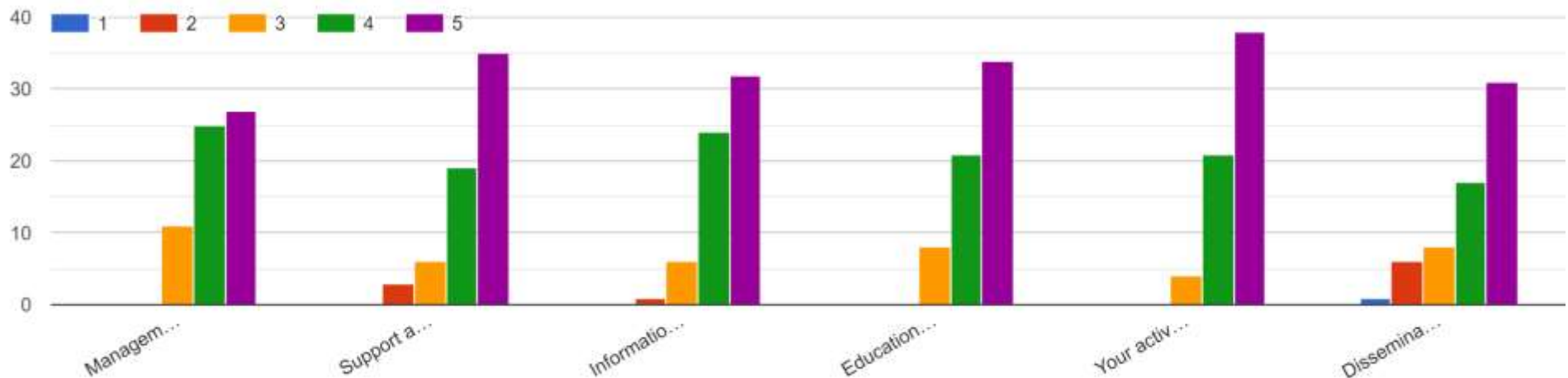
Evaluation of the organization and activities of the YE "GREEN PLAN TO PLANT (GREPLA-PLA)" from participants.

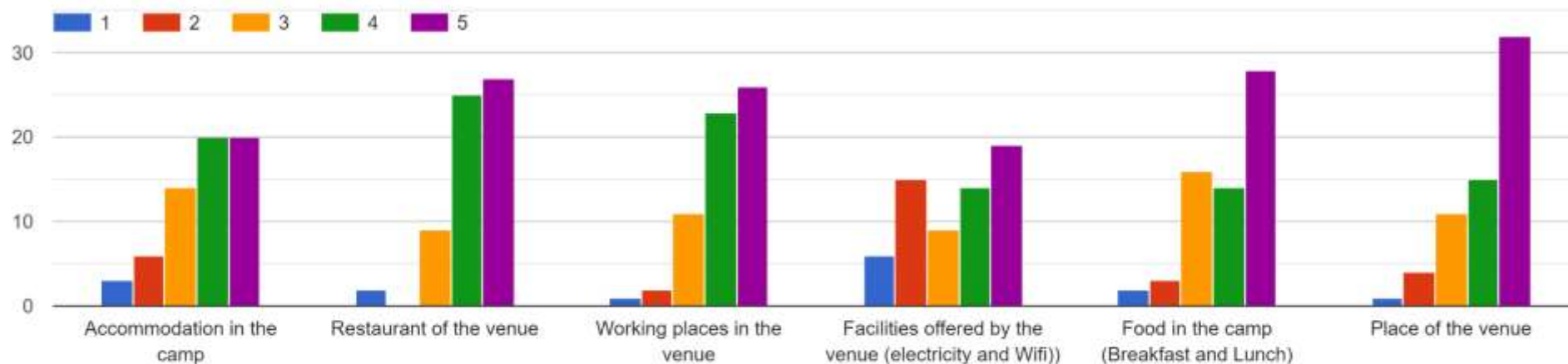

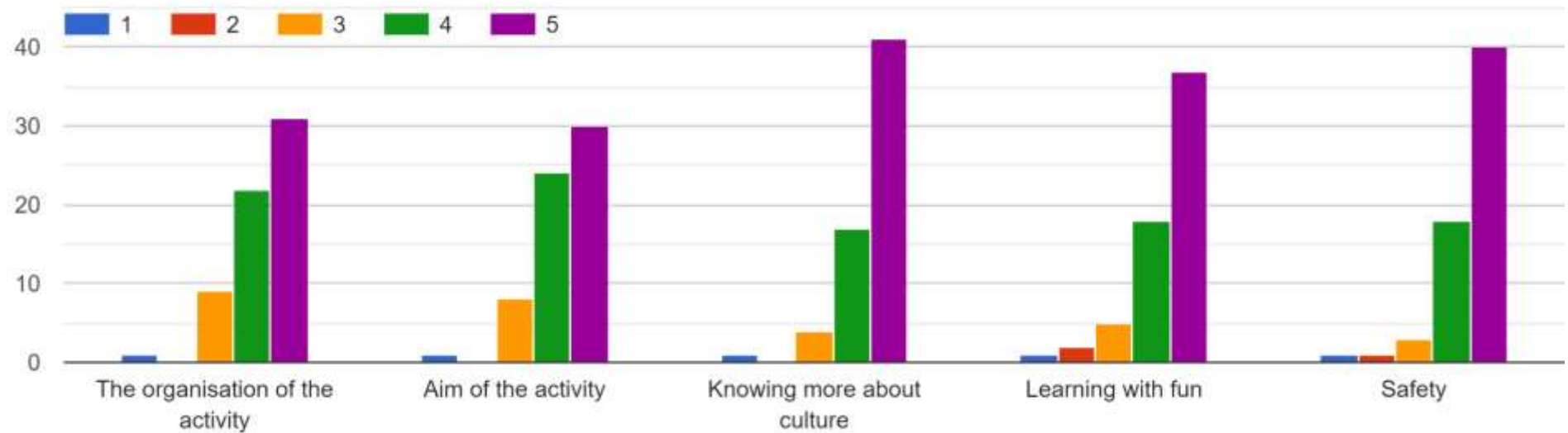
More space for participants, we were 5-6 people in a small tent and could barely fit

pls no more tents i want 4 walls and a roof

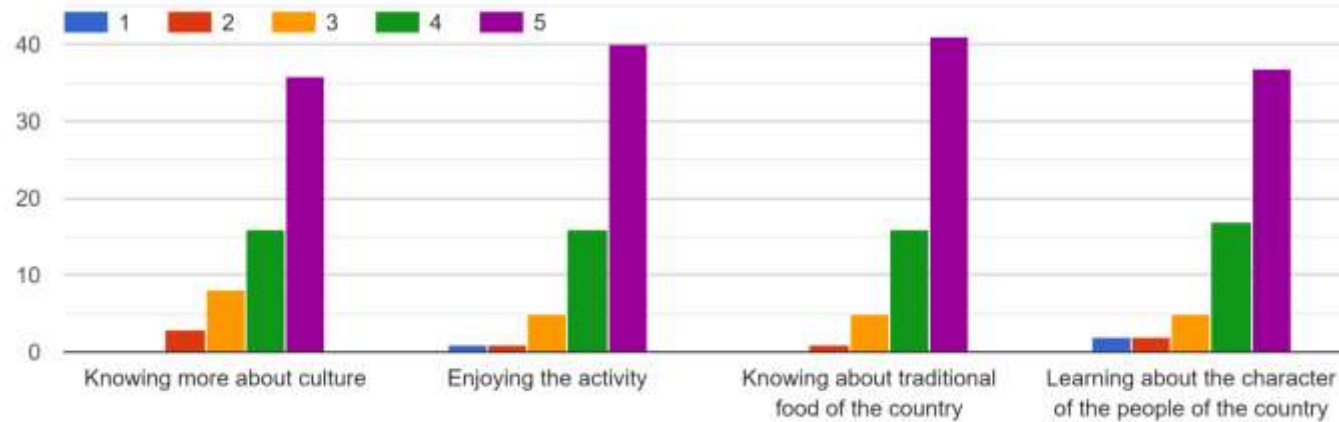
