

What does Shumen think about the environment?


We surveyed 172 people including:

- 120 students from different schools
- 39 people in the work force
- 8 elderly
- 5 university students

76.5%


75% of Shumen folk report negative effects from environmental problems, including, but not limited to:

- Health issues
- Air and water pollution
- Ruined image of the city
- Harm to domestic and street animals
- Unpleasant smells
- Uncontrolled littering and cutting of trees



“Environmental protection is taught! It should be introduced into the educational system and perceived by society as a value.”

Supermarkets should have points for selling glass packaging, cans, bottles etc. to stimulate the separate collection of waste.



“Improving public transport to reduce the use of cars.”



“Reducing the tax on buildings heated by electricity.”

“Cleaning small neighborhoods and streets, not only around the center, and investing in a water purification station.”

“Afforestation and greening of spaces between apartment complexes.”

“More separate waste bins and bins in general.”



“Introduction of anti-pollution laws with monetary penalties.”

Volunteering and participation in environmental initiatives

- 57.6% of people have participated before
- 79.7% of people would participate if there are more opportunities
